

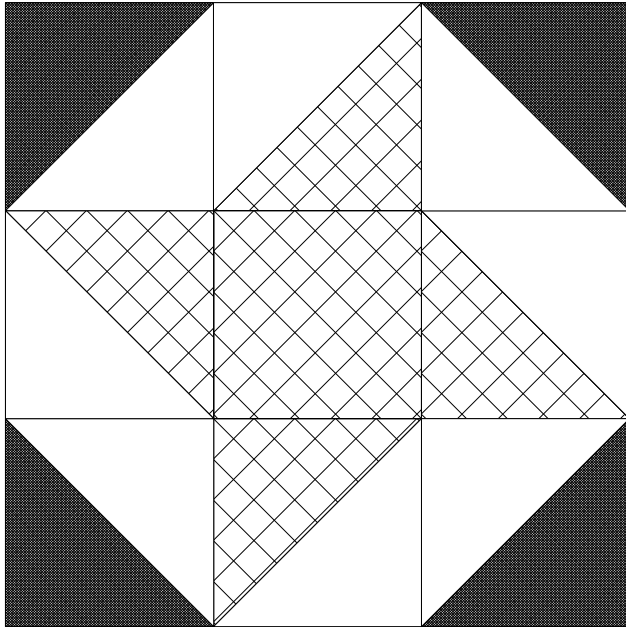
# Hearts 'n' Hands Quilt Guild

## Block of the Month due at the February 2010 Meeting

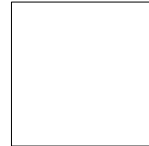
### Ribbon Quilt

adapted from *501 Rotary-Cut Quilt Blocks* by Judy Hopkins

Directions for 6" [9", 12"] Finished Blocks

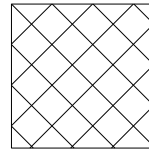


### Cutting Directions



#### **Fabric #1**

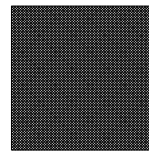
Four 3" [4", 5"] Squares



#### **Fabric #2**

Two 3" [4", 5"] Squares

One 2½" [3½", 4½"] (Center)



#### **Fabric #3**

Two 3" [4", 5"] Squares

### Sewing Directions

On the wrong side of the four Fabric #1 Squares, draw a pencil line diagonally from corner to corner. Pin them to the Fabric #2 & Fabric #3 Squares measuring 3" [4", 5"], right sides together. Sew ¼" seams on both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the pencil lines and press away from Fabric #1. Square these eight units up to 2½" [3½", 4½"].

Lay units and center square out as illustrated in diagram. Sew units into rows, pressing seams for Rows 1 & 3 towards outer units and Row 2 towards center square. Sew rows together. Block should measure 6½" [9½", 12½"].
