

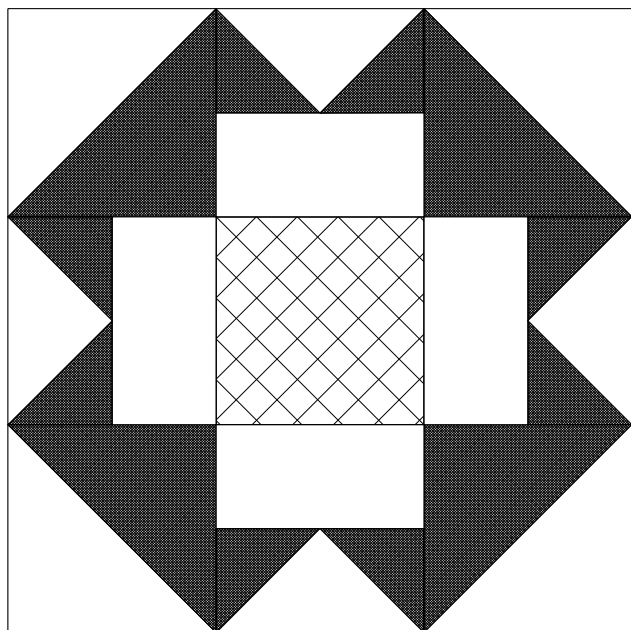

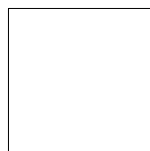

Directions for 6" [9", 12"] Finished Blocks



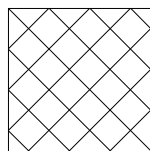
Cutting Directions

Fabric #1



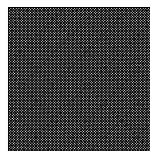
Two 3" [4", 5"] Squares

Eight 1½" x 2½" [2" x 3½",
2½" x 4½"] Rectangles



Fabric #2

One 2½" [3½", 4½"] Squares



Fabric #3

Two 3" [4", 5"] Squares

Eight 1½" [2", 2½"] Squares

Sewing Directions

Flying Geese Units – On the wrong side of the eight 1½" [2", 2½"] dark squares (Fabric 3), draw a diagonal line. On the drawn line, sew one dark square to an end of a light (Fabric 1) rectangle. Repeat for the three remaining rectangles. Trim the excess fabric ¼" from the seam line and press towards the dark fabric. Repeat with the four remaining dark squares on the opposite end of the light rectangles.

With right sides together, sew the four light rectangles (Fabric 1) to the four Flying Geese units. Be sure the triangle point of the Flying Geese unit is the edge sewn to the light rectangle. Press towards the light rectangle.

Half-Square Triangle Units – On the wrong side of the two light (Fabric 1) squares, draw a pencil line diagonally from corner to corner. Pin these squares together with the two dark (Fabric 3) squares, right sides together. Sew ¼" on both sides of the pencil line. Cut apart on the line. Press seam towards the light fabric and trim away any dark fabric "shadowing" in the seam allowance. Square the four units to 2½" [3½", 4½"].

Lay units out as shown in diagram. Sew units together into rows. Press rows 1 & 3 towards outer units. Press row 2 towards center. Sew rows together. Square block to 6½" [9½", 12½"].
