

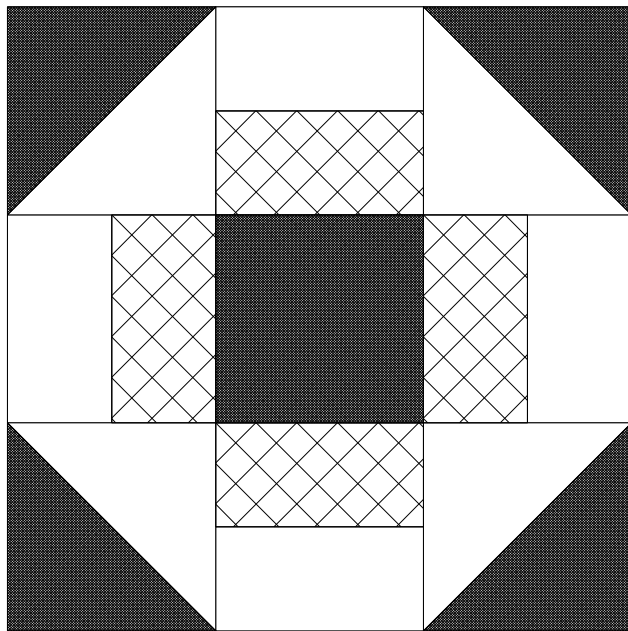

Greek Cross #1646c

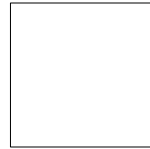

Directions for 6" [9", 12"] Finished Blocks



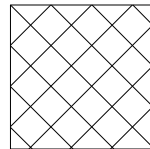
Cutting Directions

Fabric #1



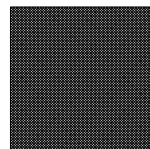
Two 3" [4", 5"] Squares

Four 1½" x 2½" [2" x 3½",
2½" x 4½"] Rectangles



Fabric #2

Four 1½" x 2½" [2" x 3½",
2½" x 4½"] Rectangles



Fabric #3

One 2½" [3½", 4½"] Squares

Two 3" [4", 5"] Squares

Sewing Directions

On the wrong side of Fabric 1 Squares, draw a pencil line diagonally from corner to corner. Pin these squares to the two larger Fabric 3 squares, right sides together. Sew ¼" on both sides of the pencil line. Cut apart on the line and press seams towards Fabric 3. Square the four units to 2½" [3½", 4½"].

Sew the long sides of the Fabric 1 Rectangles to the long sides of Fabric 2 Rectangles, right sides together. Press seams towards Fabric 2. These units should also measure 2½" [3½", 4½"].

Lay units and center square out as illustrated in diagram. Sew units into rows, pressing seams for Rows 1 & 3 towards outer units and Row 2 towards center square. Sew rows together. Block should measure 6½" [9½", 12½"].
