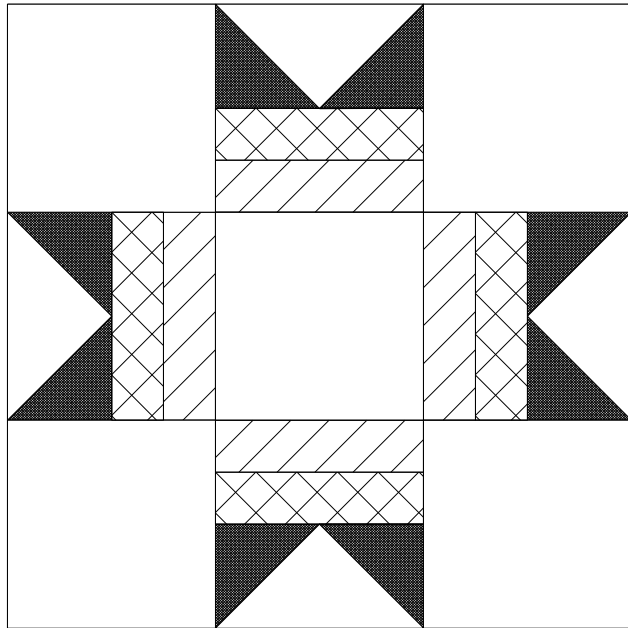

### Millennium Block

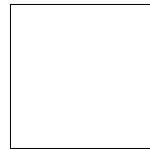

#### Cutting Directions



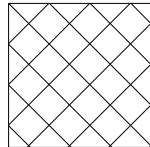
#### **Fabric #1**



Five 2½" [3½", 4½"] Square

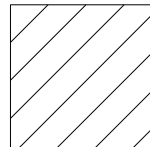
Four 1½" x 2½" [2" x 3½",  
2½" x 4½"] Rectangles

#### **Fabric #2**



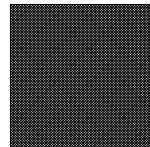
Four 1" x 2½" [1¼" x 3½",  
1½" x 4½"] Rectangles

#### **Fabric #3**



Four 1" x 2½" [1¼" x 3½",  
1½" x 4½"] Rectangles

#### **Fabric #4**



Eight 1½" [2", 2½"] Squares

#### Sewing Directions

Flying Geese Units – On the wrong side of the eight (Fabric 4) dark squares, draw a diagonal line. On the drawn line, sew one dark square to an end of the light (Fabric 1) rectangle. Repeat for the three remaining rectangles. Trim the excess fabric ¼" from the seam line and press towards the dark fabric. Repeat with the four remaining dark squares on the opposite end of the light rectangles.

With right sides together, sew the four sets of medium rectangles (Fabrics 2 & 3) together. Next, sew the four rectangle units to the four Flying Geese units. Be sure the triangle point of the Flying Geese unit is the edge sewn to the medium rectangles. Press towards the medium rectangles.

Lay units out as shown in diagram. Sew units together into rows. Press rows 1 & 3 towards outer units. Press row 2 towards center. Sew rows together. Square block to 6½" [9½", 12½"].
